THE GLOBES DE CRISTAL AWARDS, A UNIQUE CEREMONY

Founded in 2006, this ceremony celebrates the French and international cultural and artistic scene. This event is the only one of its kind to recognise the following categories: film, theatre, music, literature, live shows, one-person shows, musical comedy and television.

By covering so many categories, the ceremony represents real cultural diversity, offering everyone the chance to celebrate and highlight the multitude of talents we have in the Arts.

The Globes de Cristal (Crystal Globes) is the only ceremony where the awards are voted for by professional Arts and Culture journalists from all media (written press, digital, TV and radio). The jury has 20 expert journalists who nominate five people in each of the 21 categories.

The Globe d'Honneur is awarded to a French artist in honour of their whole career.

In 2019, this award will also be given to an international artist.

The Globes de Cristal also recognises generosity, altruism and solidarity, values cherished by its new President, who has decided that an award will be given to a charity every year.

Mehdi Hamdi, the new Globes de Cristal President, has breathed new life into the awards in a number of ways. He is looking to the future by making the ceremony more international, and by 2020 plans to hold Globes de Cristal awards in other countries, stating loud and clear the universal power of Art and Culture in all its forms.



To mark the 50th anniversary of the Directors' Fortnight held during the Cannes Festival 2018, the 'Globes de Cristal' brand has partnered with SFR (Société des Réalisateur de Films, the French directors' guild), offering its support in honouring an exceptional director, Martin Scorsese.

THE PRESS IN THE SPOTLIGHT







She was therefore the obvious choice to update the Globes de Cristal, working closely with its President.


"In our globalised world, where news about culture spreads very quickly, it's important to be easily recognisable and identifiable.
